



## Coaches & Advisors Stipend Schedule 2018 - 2019

- Coaches and advisors will be paid a stipend based on a percentage of the certified lane of the school district salary schedule as shown below. Only years as a coach or advisor will be considered for this schedule.

<sup>1</sup> If Drill Team and Cheerleading are combined, coaches may divide 2 head coach stipends and 1 assistant stipend as agreed upon by the coaches. If Drill Team and Cheerleading are separate, each may divide 1 head coach stipend and half of 1 assistant coach stipend. If there is only one coach they cannot combine stipends.

<sup>2</sup> Track has been approved to have one assistant coach stipend

<sup>3</sup> The Student Body Officers advisor will receive half of a Tier 2 activity stipend

- The school district will pay a stipend for 1 head coach and 1 assistant coach for each Tier 1 Sport. Tier 2 Activities will not have paid assistant coaches unless specifically approved by the school board.
- Assistant coaches will be paid on the on the Tier 2 Activities schedule. Head coaches may divide the assistant coach stipend between multiple assistant coaches.
- Head coaches that are not full-time employees of the school district will receive an additional \$300 for sports where practice is reasonably expected to be held during school hours.
